

SCHOOL GARDEN COMPETITION TERMS & CONDITIONS

Prizes

• Grand Prize Winner: \$1,000 & school banner

Runner-up Prize: \$500Finalist Prizes: \$100

Eligibility Criteria

- Schools must be located within the Fairfield City LGA
- Students and/or the broader school community must be involved in garden upkeep
- Gardens that are maintained solely by external contracts are not eligible

Judging

• The school must be available for a judging panel to visit and take photos of the nominated gardens during October/November

Award Presentation

All finalists must be available to attend Council meeting on Tuesday 26 November 2024 at 7pm

Judging Criteria

General garden surrounds

 How well the general school garden contributes to the character and beauty of the surrounding streets and internal school grounds

Vegetable and/or Ornamental garden

The quality and effectiveness of the design and layout:

- The overall layout, design and form of the garden
- The use of texture, scale, proportion, materials and colour, use of space and the quality of each individual space
- The inclusion of recycling functions e.g., composting

The use of materials and elements to enhance the design:

- Quality of those materials and elements
- Student artworks, signage and seating/educational space
- The diversity of plant material to achieve visual and productivity benefits for the garden

School Community Involvement

- How involved students are in maintaining the gardens
- How involved the broader school community are in the gardens (i.e., teachers, GA, P&C)
