EXCITING PROGRAM OF NEW WORKS



Just over \$54 million in funding was secured from the NSW Government's Western Sydney Infrastructure Grants program, which is going towards these new projects:



INDOOR ENTERTAINMENT AND SPORTING CENTRE

The complex will include an exhibition hall, open air amphitheatre, courtyard and covered forecourt, event foyer, outdoor stage and large hall with seating capacity for 4,000 people.



ENDEAVOUR SPORTS PARK

Works include converting the netball courts to multipurpose courts for netball, basketball, volleyball, futsal and pickleball, complete with new lighting; two new synthetic fields with lighting; football and cricket pitches with increased lighting; and an upgrade to amenities buildings.



AVENEL PARK

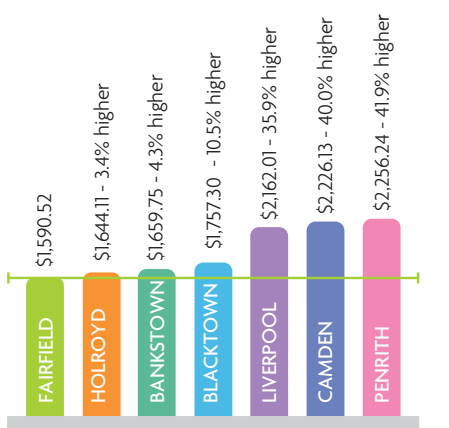
Works include multi-use sports courts, Ninja-style obstacle course, fitness and gym equipment, skate park and running loop track.



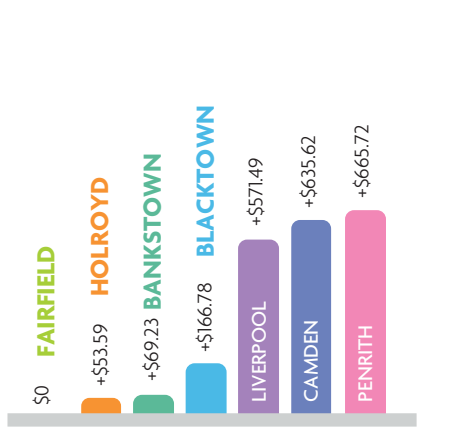
WORKING HARD TO KEEP RATES LOW

Comparable rates and charges based on land value of \$700,000 and a standard 240 litre bin for domestic waste.

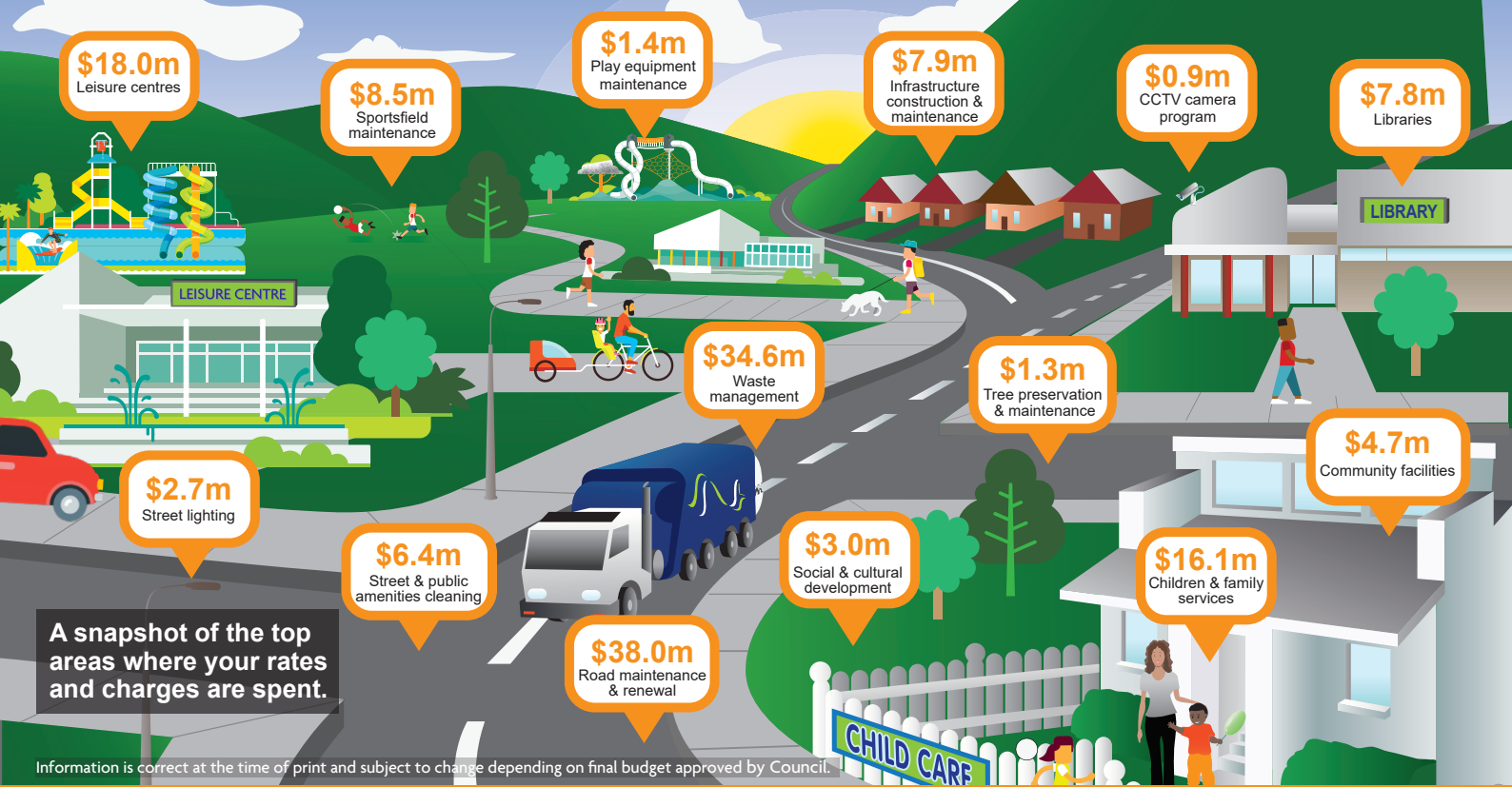


If we charged other councils' rates, this is how much more residents would have to pay per year.

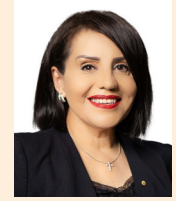
